THINGS YOU NEED TO DO BEFORE YOU LEAVE:

1. Register for the festival. If you haven't done this already, you'll need to do it onsite at this point. The price at the festival is \$115.
2. Download the KCACTF Guidebook. Follow this link and then follow the instructions.

3. Go through Festival schedule and find your workshops and competition times.
4. Request to join the "UVU KCACTF 2018 Mesa Arizona" group on Facebook. We can use this for mass communication at the festival and prior to it.
5. Send Lisa an email letting her know if you're riding the bus or providing your own transportation to the festival.

BUS INFORMATION:

- The bus will leave **VERY** early in the morning at UVU on Monday, February 12th and in Mesa on Sunday, February 18th. Plan to be there at **5:00 AM** to check in, get all the luggage gathered, and ensure all the paperwork is in order.
- The bus will be picking up on Monday and dropping off on Sunday at the Faculty Annex on UVU Campus.
- Please bring **only** 1 suitcase and one backpack! If you'd like a pillow or snacks on the bus, that's fine. But pick up any trash you bring on.
- The bus will make scheduled stops for food and bathroom breaks and that schedule is forthcoming.
- Make sure you bring headphones so you aren't disturbing others on the bus with music or sound.
- The drive will be approximately 10.5 hours

GENERAL CODES OF CONDUCT AT FESTIVAL:

- **No drugs of any kind.** If you're found to have them, you'll be asked to leave.
- **No alcohol in the hotel rooms.** If you're found to have that, you'll be asked to leave.
- **If you are over 21 and choose to drink, please do so responsibly.** Coming back to your room and getting sick is not drinking responsibly. Showing up for ACTF events (whether you're performing/presenting or not) drunk or hungover is unacceptable.
- **Keep sound to a minimum in the halls and rooms,** as we've had complaints in the past.
- **Anyone who doesn't return to their room to sleep** may be checked up on by faculty to ensure everyone's safety.
- **Please visit with friends in common areas,** rather than rooms, so that everyone can sleep, prepare, or hang out without large groups in their space.
- **Please keep rooms clean and don't break anything.** Students will be financially responsible for damage to the rooms.
- **Please be punctual.** Be on time to your rounds, workshops, and bus departures.

This experience is usually an awesome one, and it's always such a thrill to see our students win awards at the ceremony on Saturday night. However, traveling together can sometimes create situations that have lasting consequences. Please keep these three things in mind:

1. **Save the gossip for the bus.** It's totally natural that we'll all want to talk about what we see. But remember that people have brought their hard work to the festival, and we expect respect for the work we bring. Don't get caught saying crappy things about another's work, because you never know who can hear you.
2. Whether or not you drink, and however you want to socialize with UVU folks or with students from other schools, **please be clear about consent.** If you're not sure if someone consents, ask. Boundaries feel fuzzy when everyone is staying together and celebrating the shows - look out for one another and be responsible for your actions. If you ever need help or backup, you will have contact info for student leaders and faculty.
3. **Make sure everyone knows what a great group of students we have here** by being good representatives of UVU, our department, and your own hard work. See #1 and #2.


